## ABOUT LIAAC

For over 25 years, the *Long Island Association for AIDS Care, Inc. (LIAAC)* has been a community-based, not-for-profit agency that provides services and support for Long Islanders (1) infected and affected by HIV/AIDS and (2) at high risk for HIV infection and other infectious diseases. *LIAAC* is the only agency serving L.I. with HIV/AIDS prevention and care as its founding purpose and core mission. *LIAAC* was the nation's first suburban-based AIDS service organization; its endurance over the past 25 years has required overcoming harmful, inaccurate stereotypes portraying all Long Islanders as affluent, healthy, and not as vulnerable to HIV or other harmful diseases as residents of neighboring New York City. *LIAAC* remains L.I.'s only bi-county, comprehensive community service provider, with the region's only HIV/AIDS Hotline. The New York State Department of Health has designated *LIAAC* as the only HIV community service provider (CSP) for Nassau and Suffolk Counties.

As the nation's oldest and largest suburban HIV/AIDS service agency, *LIAAC* has long established relationships with support organizations in Nassau and Suffolk Counties, including primary healthcare facilities, substance abuse treatment centers, mental health organizations, hospitals, shelters, and soup kitchens. These partnerships enable us to work together and help thousands in need.
