The goal of this awareness day is to educate individuals on condom use and increase their comfort level in opening up a healthy dialogue with their partners on the benefits of condom use. When used consistently and correctly, condoms protect against sexually transmitted infections, HIV, and unplanned pregnancy. The Long Island Association for AIDS Care supports the use of male latex condoms and female condoms to limit the spread of HIV and STIs.

In observance of International Condom Day, LIAAC will have a table in Five Towns College on Wednesday, February 17th, where information pamphlets and condoms will be distributed. This is an open event to all students aimed at promoting safer sex.
