February is National Condom Month, an awareness event intended to promote discussion about the correct use of condoms. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, “Consistent and correct use of the male latex condom reduces the risk of sexually transmitted disease (STD) and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) transmission.” The Long Island Association for AIDS Care provides male latex and non-latex condoms, female condoms, and dental dams free to the public to help limit the spread of HIV and other STIs.

In observance of National Condom Day, LIAAC will be providing free and confidential mobile testing for HIV, Hepatitis C, and sexually transmitted infections, as well as participating in a social media campaign focused on normalizing the discussion surrounding condom use.
