International Condom Awareness Day, Long Island Association for AIDS Care (LIAAC) launches education and HIV testing initiative

February 14th, 2014 is International Condom Day. National Condom day was created to raise awareness on the protection condoms, when used correctly, provide against sexually transmitted infections and unplanned pregnancy when used correctly. The Long Island Association for AIDS Care supports use of male latex condoms and female condoms to limit the spread of HIV and STIs.

In recognition of National Condom Awareness Day 2014, the Long Island Association for AIDS Care will be conducting HIV testing and HIV/STI education initiatives. Project REACH will be testing at Stony Brook University as part of their “Love Carefully” event, on Friday, February 14, 2014, from 9AM until 1PM.
