Long Island Association for AIDS Care (LIAAC) recognizes the importance of **National HIV Testing Day on Friday, June 27th**. Youth aged 13 to 24 accounted for an estimated 26% of all new HIV infections in the United States in 2010, according to data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. According to the New York State Epidemiological Profile in 2012, Nassau and Suffolk Counties have the highest number of newly diagnosed HIV cases among suburban communities in the state.

In recognition of National HIV Testing Day, Long Island Association for AIDS Care (LIAAC) will be conducting free testing and outreach events at Walgreens Pharmacy in Hempstead (393 Front Street, Hempstead, NY 11550) and Walgreens Pharmacy in Amityville (275 Broadway, Amityville, NY 11701) from 11AM-6PM. This event will include HIV Rapid Testing, HCV Screening, Blood Pressure Checks, Shingles Shots, Meningitis Shots, and more.
